MCKS Charity Ireland - Schools:

In 2023 we piloted a new donation programme in two schools aiming to feed children who may otherwise come to school with no breakfast or lunch. In a school in Co Westmeath, we funded a breakfast club which ensures each child has something to eat before they start school. In Dublin City Centre we funded a feeding programme for 2023/2024 which targets children from disadvantaged backgrounds. This funding provides a nutritious lunch each day for the school year. To complete this programme a little over €9,000 was donated to the schools.
